

LCA PAIN CLINIC INSTRUCTIONS (Mercy Medical Center)

- 1.) Your appointment is scheduled on _____
Day Date
Patient must arrive at the Pain Clinic at _____ am/pm.
Please call (319) 743-7301 if you need to reschedule. A fee will apply if you miss this appointment without providing 24 hours notice.
- 2.) If an injection is done, patients must:
 - Have a driver to take them home.
 - Have a responsible adult stay with you for 24 hours after the procedure if receiving sedation.
- 3.) Please complete the attached Pain Assessment form before you arrive at the Pain Clinic. If you do not have this form, it is available on our Web site: www.cr-painclinic.com
- 4.) Eating/Drinking instructions (if a procedure may be performed)
 - NO solid foods 6 hours before appointment
 - Clear liquids up to 2 hours before appointment
 - (This means nothing by mouth 2 hours before your appointment)
- 5.) Medications:
 - If you are taking any blood thinners, such as **Coumadin, Plavix, Aggrenox, Pradaxa, Effient, Xarelto, Brilinta (Ticagrelor)**, or any other blood thinner, please call the Pain Clinic at (319) 398-6636.
 - Aspirin: Do not take any aspirin or aspirin-containing products during the 24 hours prior to your appointment. Other pain medicines (ibuprofen, acetaminophen, naproxen, etc.) may be taken through your appointment time.
 - If you have an infection, are running a temperature, or **taking an antibiotic** please call the Pain Clinic at (319) 398-6636.
 - Diabetics: Contact the Pain Clinic for instructions at (319) 398-6636 at least two days prior to your appointment.
 - Insulin dependent diabetics: Check a blood sugar at home the day of your appointment. Call the Pain Clinic at (319)398-6636 if your blood sugar is greater than 250 mg/dl.
 - Please take all other morning medications with water (small amount)
- 6.) Questions:
 - For questions concerning medications, eating/drinking instructions or directions, call the Pain Clinic at 398-6636 or (800) 426-3729 x 6636 (M-F, 9:00-4:00)

- 7.) Directions:

Park in Mercy Medical Center's 8th street parking ramp near the North Entrance on any level (ground floor through 3rd floor). Take Elevator C to the 4th floor. Exit the elevator to your left. Turn right at the hallway toward the Pain Management Clinic.
- 8.) To schedule a follow-up visit at the Pain Clinic:

Future visits to our Pain Clinic for the *same pain problem* can be authorized by Pain Clinic personnel for up to one year from your first visit. Please call the Pain Clinic for authorization and an appointment. If you have a new/different pain problem, your referring physician must contact the Pain Clinic with a new referral.
- 9.) It is your responsibility as the patient to check with your insurance/worker's comp carrier to determine whether pre-certification/pre-authorization is required. If needed, please contact your doctor's office to assist you with this process. Referral authorizations should be faxed to the Pain Clinic at (319) 369-4523.

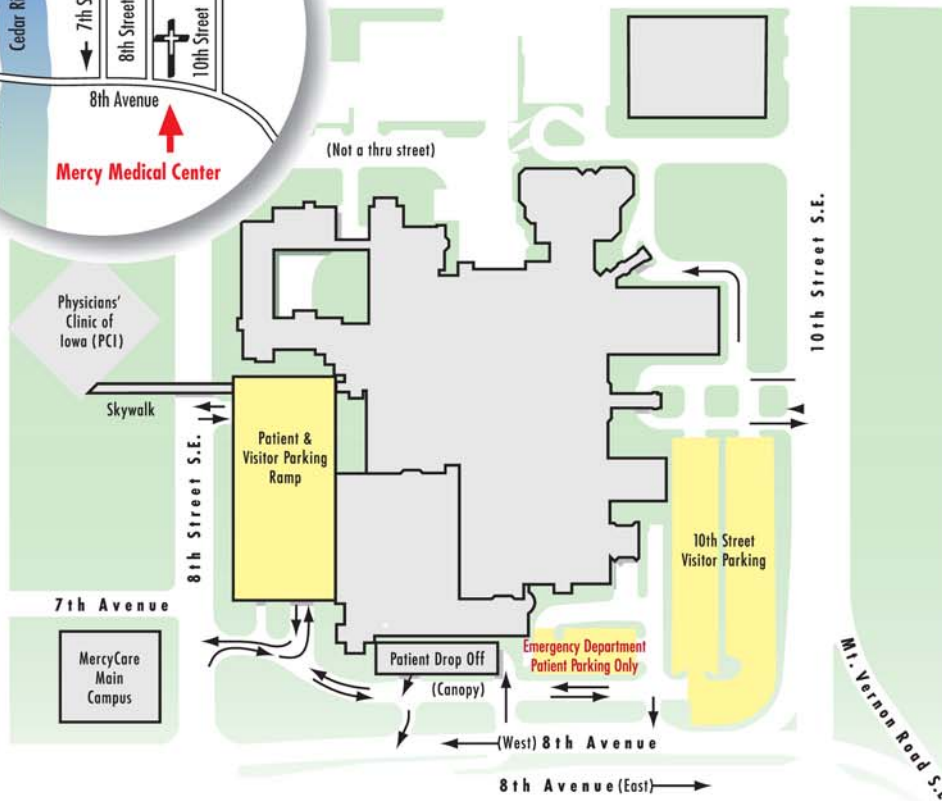

HOW TO FIND US

From Highway 30 East or West

Take the I-380 N exit.

Approaching from the South (on I-380)

Heading northbound on I-380, take the Diagonal Drive exit (#19A) and turn right (east). Diagonal Drive curves left over the Cedar River and turns into 8th Avenue SE. Mercy is about 8 blocks on your left. (Turn left on 8th Street to access the parking ramp.)

Approaching from the North (on I-380)

Heading southbound on I-380, take the 7th Street exit (#20B). Stay on 7th Street heading south for about 9 blocks. Turn left (east) on 8th Avenue SE. Mercy is one block on your left. (Turn left on 8th Street to access the parking ramp.)

Parking/Directions to the Pain Clinic

Park in the 8th Street parking ramp (accessible from either 8th Street or 8th Avenue). You may park on any level (ground through 3rd floor) and enter the building at the North entrance. Take the "C" elevator to the 4th floor. Reserved parking is available at the North entrance of the 3rd floor and is marked "Pain Management."
